Dear Gladys:

The Municipality of Broughton Island currently has a valid water licence N4L3-0640 with the Nunavut Water Board. This water licence regulates water use and waste disposal activities.

Part D, Item 4 of the Licence requires the Municipality to notify the Inspector at least ten (10) days prior to initiating the decant of the Sewage Lagoon.

Part H, Item 1 required the Municipality to submit an operation and maintenance plan before August 1996. The OM plan regulates waste disposal facilities and would outline current solid waste disposal practices including 'burn and bury'. Given that this plan was not submitted we are somewhat in the dark and should be advised of any solid waste management activities.

In my view these activities are not subject to NIRB screening because they fall within an established municipality and are regulated under a valid water licence.
