Re: Airport Rehabilitation, Broughton Island

Dear Sir/Madam

The Department of Transportation plans to upgrade and resurface the existing airport facility on Broughton Island. The work involves an extension of the runway to 1219 m as shown on the attached plan. The work requires the installation of a new 1800 mm culvert at approximate station 1+300 and the replacement of an existing culvert at approximate station 1+080. Details of the proposed culvert installations are also included.

In accordance with the requirements of the Nunavut Final Lands Claims Agreement we are seeking your approval to proceed with these installations. Both installations are within the current airport boundaries and are necessary to ensure adequate drainage around the existing and to be expanded runway.
