Review of 2001 Annual Report - Municipality of Qikiqtarjuaq - NWB3QIK

Please accept this letter as notification that the 2001 Annual Report submitted to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) by the Municipality of Qikiqtarjuaq for the water use and waste disposal, as required under water licence NWB3QIK0106 (Part B, Item 1), has been reviewed by Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC).

Attached for your records is the 2001 Compliance Report. Compliance reports are prepared annually in order to assess the Licensee's compliance with the terms and conditions of their water licence.

The Licensee was found to be in non-compliance with three conditions of water licence NWB3QIK0106.

- The Licensee did not complete the sampling or analysis required by the Surveillance Network Program. INAC would like to remind the Licensee that presenting the results of the Water Resource Officer's sampling does not constitute as performing the required sampling for the Surveillance Network Program.
- The effluent standards regarding biological oxygen demand and feacal coliform were not met.
- The Licensee is now one year overdue with the submission of their Operations and Maintenance Plan, which was due July 1, 2001. In their Annual Report, it is mentioned that the plan is pending funding approval from Community Government and Transportation (CG&T). By copy of this letter and compliance report to CG&T, we hope that they will help the community deal with this outstanding issue in a timely manner.

Introduction

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) issued water licence NWB3QIK0106 to the Municipality of Qikiqtarjuaq on November 28, 2000. The licence is valid from the period of January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2006. This Report assesses compliance with the licence for the period between January 1, 2001 and December 31, 2001. This report draws its conclusions from the information provided in Qikiqtarjuaq's 2001 Annual Report (2002-04-02) as well the Inspector's report from his September 6, 2001 inspection (2001-11-09).

The Licensee has complied with this section. There were no unauthorized discharges in 2001.

The Licensee has not yet submitted any terms of reference, however, no deadline has yet been missed. The Licensee is thus still in compliance with this section.

The Licensee has not yet submitted the plan referred to in Part I, Item 1, however, no deadline has yet been missed. The Licensee is thus still in compliance with this section.

INAC believes there is an error in the licence and that Part H, Item 3 is intended to refer to the proposal in Part I, Item 1.

Not applicable since the plan from Part I, Item 1 has not yet been approved by the NWB.

Conclusion

During the year currently under review (2001), the Licensee was found to be in non-compliance with the following items of licence NWB3QIK0106:

• Part B, Item 2: The Licensee did not complete the sampling or analysis required by the Surveillance Network Program. INAC would like to remind the Licensee that presenting the results of the Water Resource Officer's sampling does not constitute as performing the required sampling for the Surveillance Network Program. As a consequence of this, the Annual Report was deemed incomplete because it did not contain the SNP results (Part B,

Item 1).

- Part D, Item 2: The effluent standards regarding biological oxygen demand and feacal coliform were not met. In his report, the Inspector believed this resulted because of insufficient treatment time due to the early decant that was required to maintain the 1 m freeboard in the sewage lagoon. He also mentions that the Community Government and Transportation (CG&T) capital plans identify resources for water use and waste disposal investigations in the community. Hopefully, this will help prevent such breach of effluent standards from happening again.
- Part G, Item 1: The Licensee is now one year overdue with the submission of their Operations and Maintenance Plan. In their Annual Report, it is mentioned that the plan is pending funding approval from CG&T. By copy of this compliance report to CG&T, we hope that they will help the community deal with this outstanding issue in a timely manner.

As a minor issue, there is no record of a 10 day notice of discharge as required by Part D, Item 5.
