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iv. a summary of modifications and/or major maintenance work carried out on the Water Supply and Waste Disposal Facilities, including all associated structures and facilities; Land Farm project is halfway constructed. Recently department of housing did a feasibility study on the current status and they are looking for an option to immediately complete this project. Water Reservoir was drained out last summer and inspected the liner at the bed. Hamlet tried to install an elbow at the intake pipe but failed. They will be attempting this summer again. a list of unauthorized discharges and summary of follow-up action taken; v. No spill occurred in the Environmental Facilities during the reporting report. vi. a summary of any abandonment and restoration work completed during the year and an outline of any work anticipated for the next year; An elbow will be installed at the end of the intake pipe this summer to draw fresh water from the reservoir. a summary of any studies requested by the Board that relate to waste disposal, water vii. use or reclamation, and a brief description of any future studies planned; The possibility of leakage through the liner of the Water Reservoir was checked and found that water does not pass through the liner. The water reservoir is safe. However, second inspection is scheduled this summer. any other details on water use or waste disposal requested by the Board by November viii. 1st of the year being reported; and Hamlet inspected the status of the liner. Hamlet also did the erosion protection of the front bank of the stream which is the hamlet's potable water source. ix. updates or revisions to the approved Operation and Maintenance Plans. The O&M manuals are available. The Hamlet is operating Water Truck fill station, Sewage Lagoon and Waste site following the guidelines of the existing O&M manuals.

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT THE LICENSEE DEEMS USEFUL:

Department of Housing is looking for additional funding to complete the construction of the land farm. Once construction is complete, the O&M manual will be available.

FOLLOW-UP REGARDING INSPECTION/COMPLIANCE CONCERNS:

Hamlet is working with CGS for INAC inspection concerns and Water Licence Compliancy. Hamlet is keeping close contact with the newly formed Water licence Compliance Group (WLCG) and receiving direction to move forward. They are engaged in extended sampling program as established by CGS.
