Following to the e-mail sent by the SAO of hamlet of Qikiqtarjuaq regarding the sewage lagoon situation.

Please note that the Department of Community Government and Transportation (CG&T) has been made aware of the current situation and is collecting further information regarding it. Depending on the outcome of the information collected, CG&T shall arrange with the hamlet for the preparation of a contingency plan to meet the requirements of their water licence and apply for an amendment to their water licence, if required.

Moreover, CG&T had anticipated long time ago the future need for the hamlet of Qikiqtarjuaq to update their municipal infrastructure. Therefore, funds have been included in the Capital Plan for assessment/upgrading the hamlet's municipal infrastructure starting this year.

Should the current investigation indicate the need for upgrading the sewage lagoon, construction work would start ASAP to accommodate the community's need and comply with the regulations.

Finally, CG&T would like to allow a couple of weeks in order to be able to collect the required information and prepare a contingency plan.
