Dear Mr. Althouse;

Re: Modifications to Sewage Treatment System

Reference: Our telephone conversation of this date.

- 1. Further to our earlier conversation, I would like to reiterate the following information:
  - a. That the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND) can not authorize your proposed changes to the sewage treatment facility, to wit, replacing the filtering screen (now 500 microns) with a large mesh size (proposed 2000 microns).
  - b. Any approvals must be from the Nunavut Water Board (NWB).
  - c. DIAND enforces the licences issued by the NWB.
  - d. Part D, Item 2 of the current licence states that the maximum average concentration of the following parameters must meet certain levels. These are:

BOD<sub>5</sub> 120 mg/L Oil and Grease 5 mg/L Suspended Solids 180 mg/L



- 2. Any modifications made to the sewage treatment system without approval of the NWB would place both the Hamlet of Rankin Inlet (Licence holder) and the Government of the Northwest Territories (DPW&S) in a position of liability by potentially violating water licence N6L3-0779 issued under the authority of the *NWT Waters Act*.
