Re: Hamlet of Resolute Bay Solid Waste Facilities (Land fill and Metal dump)- Water Licence # 3BM-RES 9699 Renewal Application

Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

I am writing you to clarify the issues and concerns of this licence renewal application. The licence # 3BM-RES 9699 initially covered both Utilidor System and existing Waste Facilities and expired on 1999. We have separated the Utilidor licence and received renewal licence # 3BM-RUT 1012 for Utilidor System only in 2010.

In 2007, we applied for renewal of Waste Management Facility which is located just opposite to Airport Sewage Lagoon considering decommissioning the existing Waste sites once this proposed site is licensed.

We discovered from the Engineering Report prepared by Arktis Solutions Inc., an Engineering Consulting Firm that this site is not suitable as the future Community Waste Management Facility. Therefore, the consultant was asked to select a new site and design for NWB approval.

The new site was selected and design was also complete. At that stage a feasibility study was conducted on waste management for entire Nunavut including Resolute Bay. GN-CGS accepted new guidelines for waste management facility. As a result, the completed design is now required to be upgraded to satisfy the new guidelines.

The Consultant started upgrading the design and at that stage, the project was declared closed until further notice.

In these circumstances, our previous submission became null and void. We are also requesting to disregard the previous submission in this letter.

In order to renew the water licence # 3BM-RES 9699 as a standalone licence only for the existing Waste Facilities (existing Land fill site and the existing Metal Dump site), please see attached the following documents to support the renewal process:
