Comments: Water source is a large lake. Municipality administers and runs the facility for the GN. Facility very old but clean and well kept. Water is pumped from lake pumping station to main distribution pumping station. This second station has very old boilers that keep the water heating and flowing in the system (utilidor). Chlorination chemicals and system in place and sampling equipment was noted on sight. The boilers in this facility are over 20 years old and require all boilers to be working to ensure water flows within the system.
