	The location and topographic layout of the Landfill make it difficult to contain wind-blown waste. The inspector requires the										
4 AV A F C 40	municipality to take the necessary measures to ensure waste does not leave the landfill area. Options to consider are building a										
fence, capping the waste more often with gravel or finding another site altogether. The landfill site is also currently unlined,											
therefore leachage may leave the landfill site and affect the surrounding area. It is the licensee's responsibility to ensure that all											
waste generated and deposited does not leave the landfills boundaries.
