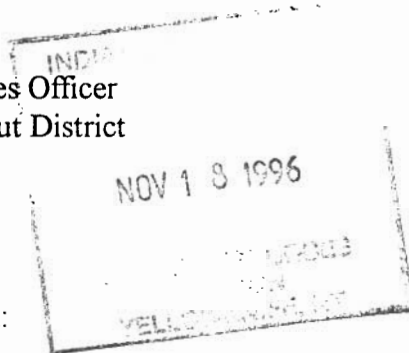

Re: Water Licence Inspection, Resolute Bay, August 23 & 29, 1996
Your file: B9545-5-N4L3-1571

This is in reply to your letter of October 16, 1996 to the Hamlet SAO, Mrs. Susan Salluviniq, concerning the unforeseen high consumption of water last year.

A review of your letter with Neil MacDonald, Settlement Maintenance Supervisor, produced the following information.

1. Last year the bleeds were turned on high, due to a frozen main.
2. The flow meter at the Water Treatment Plant was working intermittently, due to a malfunctioning sensor, caused by power outages, phone line interruptions, and high moisture in the transmission lines. This has been corrected since Neil returned from vacation September 9th.

The flow meter sensor at the Char Lake Pumphouse is being checked for proper operation by Narwhal Arctic Services technician.

3. The meters for Narwhal Arctic Services, and the Polar Continental Shelf Project always operated correctly, but the Hamlet requested they be changed from gallons to litres. This was completed two weeks ago.

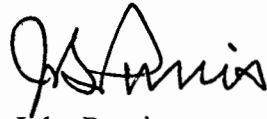
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4. Attached is correspondence from Neil concerning a recent incident involving a request from the Housing Association for water bleeds on all their houses. This matter has now been resolved by DPW and the Hamlet.

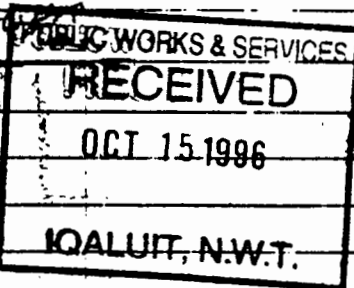
