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This licence deals only with solid waste management of the Hamlet of Resolute Bay. Initially this facility was under the Utilidor system. In 2010 Utilidor licence was renewed without this facility.

An attempt was made to renovate the 2000 built solid waste site located next to the Airport. But it was found unacceptable following the recommendation by the Consultant Arktis Solutions Inc. The consultant has been advised to identify a new site and complete the design works of that facility.
