Dear Phyllis,

I am writing on behalf of the Municipality of Sanikiluaq in response to your e-mail dated November 20, 2009. The clarification of your e-mail is as follows:

1. **Water Truck fill Station:** The Previous response is same. This facility will be maintained with minor repairing works during this winter. In 2010, it will be replaced completely. The Consultant is on board and they are currently working on the design.
2. **Sewage Lagoon:** This is in 2010-11 capital estimates. Once budget is approved, we will start working on this project. The new design of the facility will satisfy the conditions and requirements of the NWB. Currently no work is planned on the existing Sewage Lagoon because we are waiting for the funding.
3. **Solid waste Management:** This is also in 2010-11 capital estimates. Once fund is approved, we will start working on the design of the facility. Currently there no plan or fund available to carry out any remedial works on this facility

The Municipality is planning to keep them under compliances within few years.
