iv. a summary of modifications and/or major maintenance work carried out on the Water Supply and Waste Disposal Facilities, including all associated structures and facilities;

Water Truck fill station has been rehabilitated and upgraded. Maintenance works will be carried out as needed basis. The geotechnical investigation of the new Sewage lagoon is complete. Design of Sewage Lagoon is in progress.

v. a list of unauthorized discharges and summary of follow-up action taken;

The existing sewage lagoon is a natural ditch. During summer, this ditch becomes full and the access water overflows to the wetland and runs towards the sea to meet the receiving body which is more than 2km away from this ditch.

Once the new Sewage lagoon is built and commissioned, the existing ditch so called lagoon will be abandoned and restored. The construction of the new sewage lagoon is not anticipated in 2014.

The studies on solid waste management were completed by Arktis Solutions Inc.

They

have produced new guidelines which have been accepted by GN. This project is on hold due to funding. Waiting for the direction from CGS Capital Planning for the next step of the process.

ix. updates or revisions to the approved Operation and Maintenance Plans.

O&M manual of the Truck fill station has been updated. The O&M manual of the new Sewage Lagoon will be prepared and made available once the new facility is built and commissioned.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT THE LICENSEE DEEMS USEFUL:

Improvement of the solid waste management and fencing are the main concerns. The Intake screen of the water truck fill station has been repaired to protect fish coming in. The hamlet started extending sampling and testing program to satisfy water Licence requirements. They are using an accredited lab called ALS Gobal in Winnipeg.

FOLLOW-UP REGARDING INSPECTION/COMPLIANCE CONCERNS:

Hamlet is working with CGS for Water Licence Compliancy. Hamlet submitted water Licence renewal application on November 13, 2013 to NWB. CGS is assisting Hamlet to prepare a Plan for Compliance following AANDC direction and will make available within April 2014.
