Subject: Application for the Renewal of Licence 3BM-SAN0308 for the Hamlet of Sanikiluaq.

Dear Mr. Roy,

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) acknowledges receipt of Government of Nunavut Department of Community and Government Services (CGS) submission, received May 12, 2009, in reply to the NWB's January 26, 2009, correspondence setting out issues arising from the NWB's preliminary technical review of the application for the renewal of Type B Water Licence 3BM-SAN0308 for the Hamlet of Sanikiluaq (Application). The NWB has reviewed the May 12, 2009, CGS submission and has determined that the Application remains incomplete.

A number of issues remain outstanding, including:

- Where specific plans required pursuant to 3BM-SAN0308 are identified in the preliminary technical review as not submitted, the CGS submission suggests that this non-compliance will continue until new facilities are built, even though the construction timeframe for new facilities is indeterminate and contingent on capital funding which has not been committed; and
- The NWB requested clarification on the segregation of materials at the Solid Waste Disposal Facility. The CGS submission suggests that the waste will not be segregated until the facility is decommissioned, with decommissioning not taking place until a new facility is built, the timing of which is subject to a five year capital plan to which funding has not been committed; and

The NWB further notes that the submission is not dated, signed or presented on letterhead.

Accordingly, to assist CGS with the submission of a sufficiently complete Application to proceed with the distribution of the Application for review and comment by interested persons, the NWB recommends that representatives of CGS and the Hamlet participate in a

teleconference with the NWB's technical staff. Please contact me directly to advise of CGS and Hamlet availability at your earliest convenience.
