Thanks for your call, following our conversation, in order to assist you with your WL Renewal Application, find below the answers to your questions.

Some Topics Related to Completing and Submitting a Renewal of WL:

1. Block # 3 Name of Project

- Hamlet of Sanikiluaq

2. Block #5 Map

A map at a 1:50,000 based on the National Topographic Series (NTS) must be provided, indicating the location of :

- the water supply
- solid waste disposal
- sewage treatment facility
- watercourses.

- 3. Block #16 Other Authorizations

- In addition to the NWB's requirements, an applicant may be required to obtain permits, licences, or other forms of approvals from territorial or federal departments or agencies with regulatory authorities in relation to certain aspects of a proposed undertaking. For example:
- Authorization for works or undertaking affecting fish habitat from Department of Fisheries and Oceans

4. Block #21 (Security) and Block #22

- They do not apply for this case.

5. Block #27 Check-list: English and Inuktitut and/or Inuinnaqtun Summaries:

This item is the same than the previously required in the old Application form.

The Board requires a one page executive summary of the application to be filed. The summary should include statements summarizing, where is appropriate, the following sections of the General Water Licence Application:

- location of Undertaking
- description of Undertaking
- water use
- quantity of water involved
- waste
- predicted environmental impacts of the undertaking and proposed mitigation measures
- water rights
- proposed time schedule

I will be glad to answer any other question(s) you have related to this topic.
