We are submitting a water License application to the Nunavut Water Board for approval. The GN will be constructing a new intake pump house/truck-fill water treatment system for the Hamlet of Taloyoak. The documents of the water system upgrades attached with this application for your approval. Presently, the lagoon/wetland sewage treatment system in Taloyoak is not engineered. Since it was never a constructed system, no drawings or engineering specifications were ever done. However, the GN will initiate the engineering study once the budget becomes available in the Capital Plan. The documents listed below are for your review and approval.

I would like to request Nunavut Water Board also to consider these points during your review process

- Community is in great need of water license
