The Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KIA) has reviewed the Nunavut Water Board's (NWB) letter of Nov 19, 2013, requesting comments on the Hamlet of Taloyoak's desire to include an un-engineered wetland as part of their sewage waste disposal facilities under their Type B water licence.

The project is not on Inuit Owned Land (IOL), and the proponent stated that it does not affect the quality, quantity or flow of waters flowing through IOL. On this file, the KIA will defer to the legal and technical responsibilities of Environment Canada, the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, and Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada.
