- The new NWT Waters Act, enacted in June 1993, requires that users of water must have a municipal water licence; at this time the Hamlet of Taloyoak does not hold such a licence. We suggest that it is important that the hamlet apply for and be granted such a licence.
- Provision of a water licence provides for the use of water, and by relationship, disposal of sewage and other municipal waste disposal facilities. We also suggest that provision of a water licence can be of assistance and can provide meaningful and sensitive considerations in the design and development of municipal services in communities of the Nunavut District.
- 3. Enclosed is a copy of the NWT Waters Act its Regulations and a copy of the Schedule III application form. Also attached for your use in facilitating this suggestion is supplemental information to aid you in completing the Schedule III application form. I have also included a draft copy of "Summary of Procedures and Information Requirements for the Applicant" to further assist you. Accompanying this application, you must also submit the information that is outlined on page 3 (section 6(d)) of the regulations. This section relates to the information that is required to be submitted when a municipal licence is being applied for.
