Deposit of Waste in Contravention of Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface
Rights Tribunal Act.

- Inspector's Direction -

I, Constantine Bodykevich; duly designated Inspector pursuant to subsection 85 (1) Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, conducted an inspection on September 5, 2003 of Taloyoak.

At the time of the drafting of this letter Taloyoak was in contravention of subsection 12 of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act. The Water Resources Officer observed drums of waste at Taloyoak with markings consistent with those used to identify Nunavut Power Corporation property.

As a stipulated in subsection 12 (1) Except in accordance with the conditions of a licence, no person shall deposit or permit the deposit of waste in any other place under conditions in which the waste, may enter waters in Nunavut.

As a stipulated in subsection 12 (3) Where waste is deposited in contravention of this section, every person who owns or has the charge, management or control of the waste, or who caused or contributed to the deposit, shall, subject to the regulations, without delay report the deposit to an inspector.

As such, under the authority vested in me pursuant to subsection 87 (1) (ii) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, I hereby direct, Earnest Merdock Director of Safety Nunavut Power Corporation to immediately:

- Immediately insure remove any 45 gallon drums of oil, fuel and solvent from all municipal solid waste disposal and storage facilities in Taloyoak.
- □ Insure that no drums of waste oil, waste fuel or other associated waste products are deposited to the municipal waste facilities of Taloyoak.

Failure to comply fully or in part with an Inspector's Direction constitutes a offence under subsection 90 (1) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act and entails, upon summary conviction, a fine of \$100,000 or to imprisonment for a term of one year, or both. Further pursuant to subsection 90 (4) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, each day on which the Inspector's Direction is not complied with shall be considered a separate offence.

Deposit of Waste in Contravention of Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act.

Inspector's Direction -

I, Constantine Bodykevich; duly designated Inspector pursuant to subsection 85 (1) Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, conducted an inspection on September 5, 2003 of Taloyoak.

Taloycak At the time of the drafting of this letter Kimmirut was in contravertion of subsection 12 of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act. The Water Resources Officer observed drums of waste at Taloyoak with markings consistent with those used for industrial purposes. These drums were not stored in accordance with Hazard Waste Guidelines.

As a stipulated in subsection 12 (1) Except in accordance with the conditions of a licence, no person shall deposit or permit the deposit of waste in any other place under conditions in which the waste, may enter waters in Nunavut.

As a stipulated in subsection 12 (3) Where waste is deposited in contravention of this section, every person who owns or has the charge, management or control of the waste, or who caused or contributed to the deposit, shall, subject to the regulations, without delay report the deposit to an inspector.

As such, under the authority vested in me pursuant to subsection 87 (1) (ii) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, I hereby direct, Scotty Edgerton to immediately:

Immediately insure that any 45 gallon drums of oil, fuel and solvent are consolidated and properly stored in an upright position with all bungs in place on level ground with no visible signs of leakage. All drums are to be stored within the municipal solid waste disposal facilities in Taloyoak. Insure that no drums of waste oil, waste fuel or other associated waste products from industrial sources (Nunavut Power Corporation) are deposited to the municipal waste facilities of

Failure to comply fully or in part with an Inspector's Direction constitutes a offence under subsection 90 (1) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act and entails, upon summary conviction, a fine of \$100,000 or to imprisonment for a term of one year, or both. Further pursuant to subsection 90 (4) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, each day or which the Inspector's Direction is not complied with shall be considered a separate offence.
