No changes. Quality testing and a bathymetric survey was conducted on Fish Lake in 2019 that confirmed that the source is suitable to act as the water supply source until at least 2049.

The water consumption in the Municipality is not expected to exceed the current allowable annual withdrawal of 30,000 m³ until at least 2041.

Less than 30,000 m³/year will be withdrawn from Fish Lake. The 2020 annual consumption was reported as 16,440 m³. The treatment process in the new water treatment plant is expected to increase the water use by less than 5% which will still be below the current allowable withdrawal maximum. The planning study indicated that consumption in 2041 is expected to be 27,010 m³, adding an additional 5% to this is 28,360 m³. Therefore, the current allowable withdrawal is expected to be sufficient for at least the next 20 years.
