Dear Mr Croucher:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) advised the Hamlet of Whale Cove, via electronic mail on May 7, 2007, that the Hamlet's municipal water Licence would expire on August 31, 2007. Following the expiration of the Licence, the Hamlet submitted an application for water Licence renewal on September 5, 2007.

On September 27, 2007, the NWB issued a separate water Licence to the Hamlet of Whale Cove for the construction and operation of a new landfarm facility to contain and treat hydrocarbon contaminated soil (3BM-WCL0712). The Licence issued for the landfarm facility was a new and separate licence and does not cover the use of water and disposal of waste for municipal activities associated with the Hamlet's expired municipal water Licence (3BM-WHA0207).

Since the submission of the renewal application form on September 5, 2007, the NWB's records indicate that key supporting information has not been submitted including:

- ➤ Water Licence Application Supplementary Questionnaire (attached); and
- Written summary of existing water use and waste disposal facilities status in English and Inuktitut.

The NWB appreciates that a portion of this information was submitted in support of the original water Licence application in 2002, which is available on the NWB's public registry. However, the NWB requests that the Hamlet confirm that the existing information remains accurate and provide updates wherever necessary.

The NWB asks that the Hamlet of Whale Cove submit the information by **Friday July 4, 2008** so that it can be provided to interested parties for review. In preparing the submission of additional information, the Hamlet of Whale Cove is encouraged to consult and address concerns raised in the Inspector's Reports. Should the Hamlet of Whale Cove require additional time, please contact me.
