The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed the technical review of the 2022, 2023 and 2024 Annual Reports (Reports) for the type B Water Licence No: 3BM-WHA2129 (Licence).

On June 30, 2025, the NWB acknowledged the receipt of the Annual Report for the year 2024 and provided it to the Kivalliq distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date. Table 1 provides a list of issues identified during the technical review of the Reports along with the recommended actions.

3	<p>The NWB notes that the Reports do not include the following information as required by Part B and I of the Licence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitoring Results for WHA-2 and WHA-4 for 2022; • Monthly and annual quantities in cubic metres of each and all Waste discharged, including the hazardous and non-hazardous Waste accepted at the Waste Disposal Facilities for 2022 and 2023; 	The Licensee is requested to provide all relevant information required by the Licence in all subsequent annual reports.

While the technical review found that the Annual Reports generally address most of the Licence requirements, the Licensee is requested to address the recommendations stated above.
