Dear Mr. Brown:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") would like to acknowledge receipt of the application for a renewal of Licence No. 3BM-YRB0308, received on November 28, 2008.

The NWB requires further information pertaining to the renewal application as per Section 48 Item 2 of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Tribunal Act (NWNSRTA)*. The applicant is requested to submit or address the following:

- 1. Executive summaries in both English and Inuktitut are required.
- 2. A site-specific Spill Contingency Plan is to be submitted.
- 3. No annual reports have been received for the entire duration of the previous Licence. The most recent annual report along with recent sewage effluent testing data is required.
- 4. An Operations and Maintenance Manual for the Sewage Disposal Facility.
- 5. An Operations and Maintenance Manual or Abandonment and Restoration Plan for the Solid Waste Disposal Facility.
- 6. On July 21, 2008 an Inspectors Direction was issued requiring the submission of a plan by November 30, 2008 to address how the Licensee would submit the required documents to bring the project back into compliance with the Licence. To date a plan specific to the 3BM-YRB0308 Licence has not been received by the NWB.

At this time, the NWB will wait upon submission of the supplemental information identified above, prior to proceeding with a thirty (30) day public review period.
