**Subject: Application for Renewal of Licence No. 3BM-YRB0308**

Dear Mr. Brown:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") would like to acknowledge receipt of the application for a renewal of Licence No. 3BM-YRB0308, received on November 28, 2008.

The NWB requires further information pertaining to the renewal application as per Section 48 Item 2 of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Tribunal Act (NWNSTTA)*. The applicant is requested to submit or address the following:

1. Executive summaries in both English and Inuktitut are required.
2. A site-specific Spill Contingency Plan is to be submitted.
3. No annual reports have been received for the entire duration of the previous Licence. The most recent annual report along with recent sewage effluent testing data is required.
4. An Operations and Maintenance Manual for the Sewage Disposal Facility.
5. An Operations and Maintenance Manual or Abandonment and Restoration Plan for the Solid Waste Disposal Facility.
6. On July 21, 2008 an Inspectors Direction was issued requiring the submission of a plan by November 30, 2008 to address how the Licensee would submit the required documents to bring the project back into compliance with the Licence. To date a plan specific to the 3BM-YRB0308 Licence has not been received by the NWB.

At this time, the NWB will wait upon submission of the supplemental information identified above, prior to proceeding with a thirty (30) day public review period.
