**- Inspector's Direction -**

I, Andrew Keim; duly designated Inspector pursuant to subsection 85 (1) *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, did, during an inspection of the Resolute Bay Airport and facilities find that the Government of Nunavut and specifically Nunavut Airports Division has failed to comply with the Water License issued pursuant the *Act*, as well as specific direction filed with the licensee in the 2007 Inspection report.

Under the authority of Section 87 (1) of the *Act*, The Government of Nunavut is hereby directed as follows;

- To provide the Inspector and the Nunavut Water Board, prior to November 30<sup>th</sup> 2008 a complete and detailed plan with defined and measurable goals and deadlines that addresses the following deficiencies;
  - Submission of an Operations and Maintenance plan for the sewage lagoon
  - Submission of an Operation and Maintenance plan or Closure Plan including Abandonment and Reclamation Activities for the solid waste management area
  - Submission of a Spill Contingency Plan for all facilities
  - Collection of samples and submission of analytical results
  - Submission of required annual reports
  - Submission of water usage and waste disposal records
  - Submission of an application for renewal of the current Water License.

Failure to comply fully or in part with an **Inspector's Direction** constitutes a offence under subsection 90 (1) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* and entails, upon summary conviction, a fine of \$100,000 or to imprisonment for a term of one year, or both.

Further pursuant to subsection 90 (4) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, each day on which the **Inspector's Direction** is not complied with shall be considered a separate offence.
