INTRODUCTION

The Resolute Bay Arctic Airports water lease # N4L3-1561 system in brief is as follows.

Water supply is from Strip Lake; the intake facility is located east of the runway. The original feed water pipe which ran in an underground and above ground utilidor, froze and broke February 29,1996. Since that date water has been hauled from Strip Lake by truck to each user. The total Resolute Airport system and Narwhal's commercial water delivery uses approximately 3,000L to 4,000L liters of water daily. This further reduction in water requirements since 1996 is due to several factors, less people on site and customers purchasing their water from the Hamlet as opposed to the Airport (Under license N4L3-1561). At peak demand, the water usage under License N4L3-1561 serviced about 16 people, however the average in 2000 was 10 people.

Sewage effluent is collected via vacuum truck from the storage tanks, which are regularly pumped out and hauled to the sewage waste disposal site, located adjacent to the old base dump (no longer in service).

In compliance with the General Conditions Part B of the Water Use and Waste Disposal License, following is the **2000 Annual Report**.

 - In 2000 there were no sewage solids removed from any sewage disposal facilities for disposal.
 - c) The pump for filling the water truck was broken in July and replaced in August once it arrived on site. During this down time water was purchased from the Hamlet of Resolute Bay's water system.


- e) In the summer of 2000 there were some minor repairs made to the sewage lagoon due to erosion. There is no major work anticipated for 2001.
- f) There were no studies requested by the Board in 2000, nor am I aware of any future studies in the planning for 2001.
- g) I am not aware of any unauthorized discharges that took place in 2000.
- There was no updates or revisions to the sewage and solid waste Operation and Maintenance Plans during 2000.
- Up to November 1, 2000 the board did not request any details on water use or waste disposal.


