Good Morning Richard, thanks for your renewal application, however I should advise you that due to recent regulatory changes in the Territory (NuPPAA legislation and amendments to NLCA) all project proposals, including amendments and renewals to/of existing projects shall be first assessed by Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) and Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) before the NWB licensing process. So you have to contact the NPC (info provided below) to see what they require for their review process.

Please be advised that under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), Article 11, Section 11.5.9 and s. 76 (1) of *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NuPPAA), the proponent of a project governed by NuPPAA is also required to submit a project proposal document (which may include the water licence application) directly to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC or Commission) for the NPC's determination regarding the applicable land use planning requirements and/or directions regarding whether the project is subject to screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board. In particular, please note that as established under Articles 11, 12 and 13 of the NLCA, NuPPAA and Part 3 of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, until the project has completed the applicable land use planning and assessment process required by the NPC and the NIRB, the NWB cannot issue a water licence.
