RE: Water License Application- Arctic Watch Lodge

Mr. Weber,

On November 23rd, 2009 the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) sent a letter via e-mail and post to your listed address indicating that as a result of the extended delay in processing your application for a Water License, it was being rejected and returned to you.

A review of the information on file indicates that since July 13th, 2009 the NWB has been awaiting further information required to properly assess and review your application for a Water license. The final document on file is an e-mail from your offices, signed by yourself and dated July 23rd, 2009 indicating that you would review the request for supplementary information at the end of your season and respond at that time.

As the NWB has not received the required information from you in the interim, your application was then rejected and returned to your offices as per the NWB's policy guidelines.

At this time I would remind you that compliance with the applicable legislation (Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act) is a requirement for you to continue your operations within the jurisdiction.

Given that there were a number of deficiencies and issues of non-compliance identified and documented in both the 2008 and 2009 inspections of your facility, it is a concern to our offices that your application has been rejected because of a failure to submit the required information.

In an effort to facilitate compliance, it is recommended that within 30 days Canadian Arctic Holidays resubmit the required application including supplementary information requested by the NWB. This will allow the NWB the required time to complete a review of your application.

Failure to comply may result in further enforcement actions as outlined in the Act being undertaken by this office.
