After seeking consultation with management we have decided that we cannot amend an inspection report to omit a violation of the terms and conditions of your water license. As you are aware, we the Inspectors do ensure the compliance of any Water Licenses that were/are issued by the Water Board. One of those compliance items that we do enforce is having the 31 metres thresholds. Your gray water tanks do fall within the 31 metres thresholds and as such do put your Water License into the non-compliance category.

Unfortunately, as stated above, we cannot amend the direction given at this time.

My recommendation is to seek consultation to remedy your concerns.
