Dear Mr. Weber:

The Nunavut Water Board (“NWB” “Board”) received on February 5, 2013 from Arctic Holidays Ltd.(the “Proponent” or “Licensee”), a revised plan entitled “Spill Contingency Plan” dated November 2012, aimed at fulfilling the relevant requirements of the terms and conditions in Licence 7BL-AWL1015.

Prior to submission of the November 2012 version of the above-mentioned plan, the Licensee had submitted two other versions of the same plan: an initial December 2009 version and an October 2012 version. The November 2012 version; however, attempted to capture and address the recommendations and comments provided by the Board and intervening parties¹ that relate to the two previous versions of the plan.

The Board has reviewed the November 2012 version of the plan, while taking into consideration interveners’ comments and recommendations provided for the preceding versions. The review determined that the document is generally acceptable and consistent with Part H, Item 1 of the terms and conditions in Licence 7BL-AWL1015. The Board has, therefore, approved the plan under **Motion No. 2013-B1-025**. The Licensee, however, is reminded of its obligations to update the spill contingency plan as often as it is required to reflect any changes in site conditions, operational conditions and scope of the project. All updates should be submitted to the Board for review and acceptance.
