The Nunavut Water Board would like to request an update on the submission of the following requested information we'll need the information to consider your water licence application complete before we can send out the application for our 30 day review period:

- A detailed spill contingency plan should be provided. The plan should included a title page, table of contents, dated prepared, effective date, background information on the site and project, emergency contact numbers, a detailed site map depicting sill kits, sumps, nearby water bodies, fuel caches, etc; measure to prevent and contain spills.
- Background information on the type of incinerator that will be used for combusting sewage and solid
 wastes should be provided. Environment Canada's Technical Document on Batch Waste Incineration is
 attached and it may help in the selection process.
- An abandonment and restoration plan (A&R Plan) should be provided (the attached example is to be used to give you an idea of the A&R plan and additional information may be requested once submitted)
