The plan should included a title page, table of contents, dated prepared, effective date, background information on the site and project, emergency contact numbers, a detailed site map depicting sill kits, sumps, nearby water bodies, fuel caches, etc; measure to prevent and contain spills. (the attached example is to be used to give you an idea of the Spill plan and additional information may be requested once submitted)
- Background information on the type of incinerator that will be used for combusting sewage and solid wastes should be provided. Environment Canada's Technical Document on Batch Waste Incineration is attached and it may help in the selection process.
- An abandonment and restoration plan (A&R Plan) should be provided (the attached example is to be used to give you an idea of the A&R plan and additional information may be requested once submitted)

We also require Nunavut Planning Commission determination prior to sending out for 30 day review period to interested parties.
