The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The activities associated with this proposal predate the establishment of Nunavut. This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NUPPAA) under section 235 of that Act. The project proposal does not require screening because it belongs to a class of works or activities set out in Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Agreement (NA), and the NPC does not have concerns regarding the cumulative impacts of the project proposal.
