Dear Sir:

It has come to the attention of the Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") that your organization is operating a Tourist Lodge in Nunavut, namely Tree River Lodge, without a valid water licence. Please be advised that in accordance with Article 13.7.1 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement...."With the exception of domestic or emergency use of waters as set out in Section 5 of the Northern Inland Water Act RSC 1985, c. N-25, no person may use water or dispose of waste into water without the approval of the NWB".

Please provide, as soon as possible, the following documents:

- 1. Water Licence Application Form (signed)
- 2. Remote Camp Questionnaire
- 3. Area Maps (no larger than 11 x 17)
- 4. English and Inuktitut project summaries
- 5. Spill Contingency Plan complete with MSDS sheets
- 6. Abandonment and Restoration Plan
- 7. Administration fee of \$30.00 (cheque, money order or Visa are acceptable. Cheques must be made payable to "Receiver General for Canada")
- 8. Water Use Fee of \$30.00 (payable on an annual basis)

All necessary documents are to be submitted electronically to my attention at the email address noted below. The application form and questionnaire are available through our ftp site at the following link: http://www.nunavutwaterboard.org/en/public_registry (user name public; password registry). Please refer to the documents in the Administration folder for the necessary forms.
