Hi Sonia,

As discussed, please find additional clarification below for ECCC#5 regarding water balance.

ECCC is asking the Proponent to provide information on how much water comes into the system, how much goes out, and where it goes in-between. It would be helpful to know how much water is split into the various internal streams (i.e. kitchen, sewage, circulation etc..), similar to ECCC #4. It would also be helpful to know if wastewater is combined with any other water stream prior to being released for treatment so that the total volume and rate for treatment can be determined. A diagram or flow chart could be useful in showing a water balance.

I hope this helps. Should you have any other questions please let me know.

I am the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) Technical Advisor assigned to the 8AC-ALT file.

I am writing with regards to the Application for renewal of the water licence 8AC-ALT made by the Department of National Defense (DND).

On July 21, 2016, the NWB distributed the DND's Application to interested parties for a completeness assessment.

A submission by ECCC dated August 26, 2016 was received by the Nunavut Water Board. I have a question regarding comment No.5 of that submission; comment No.5 states :

"ECCC requests that the Proponent provide the flow volumes to be treated including source (i.e. sewage, kitchen, circulation water) qualities and quantities"

The Proponent has required further clarification on this point.

Please, could you explain a bit more and direct the Applicant on the ECCC request regarding point No.5 of your submission?
