July

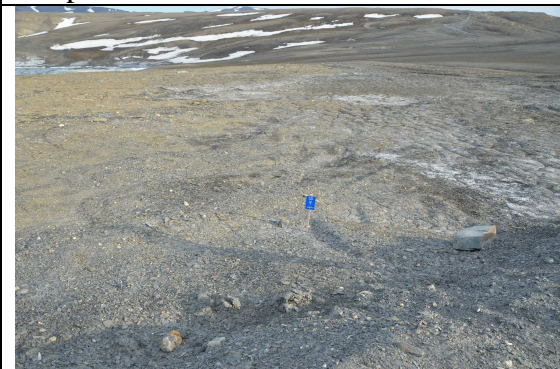

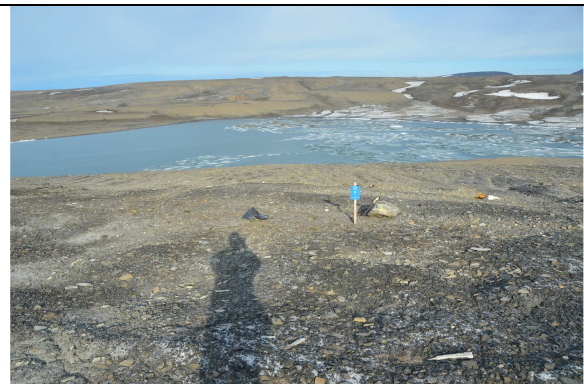
Photograph of site conditions of ALT-4 in July 2015 showing surface flow; water samples were obtained.

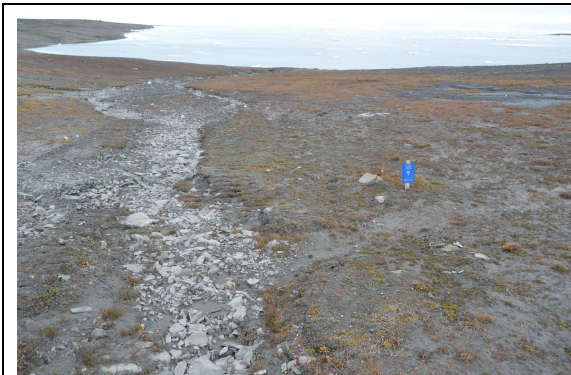
Photograph of site conditions of ALT-5 in July 2015 to show dry conditions.



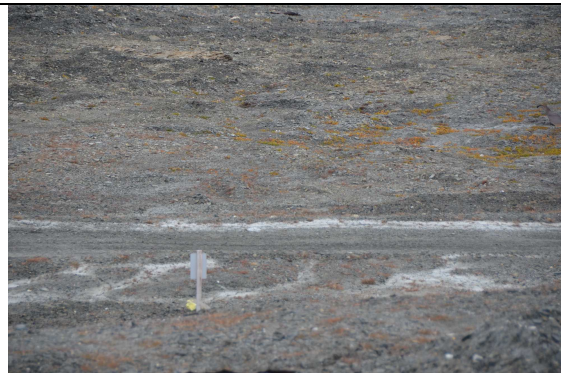
Photograph of site conditions of ALT-7 in July 2015 to show dry conditions.
