Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) submitted a Type B Water Licence Amendment Application for Water Licence 8BC-EUR2131 on March 31, 2023. The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) responded to the Application submission with various comments and recommendations on April 6, 2023. As per comment #1, the NWB suggested that a Water Licence Modification (as opposed to an Amendment) would be more suitable for permitting the new landfarm. The purpose of this Memo is to request that the Amendment Application submitted on March 31, 2023, be withdrawn, and subsequently resubmitted as a Type B Licence Modification. In summary, this request is for NWB to treat ECCC's Water Licence Amendment Application submitted on March 31, 2023, as a Water Licence Modification Application.
