Work completed in 2012/13

- a. Rigid Fuel containment systems for fuel storage areas have been purchased.
- b. Storage building replacement project tender for design was terminated and alternate solution for design developed.
- c. Geotechnical drilling and analysis for Water Lagoon proposed location and identification of aggregate source quantity and quality of proposed borrow sources has been initiated.
- d. Sewage treatment plant study completed which identifies 3 possible technologies suitable for Eureka location and to meet the Federal Guidelines for effluent discharge.
- e. Runway Surface Recapitalization project design at 90% completion.
- f. Building demolition audit 90% completed.
- g. Barrel washer crusher system specifications complete and ready for tender.
- h. Fuel tank farm supply piping retrofit project introduced for capital approval.

Work planned for 2013/14 (see Appendix K PWGSC Project Schedule)

- a. Shipping of Fuel containment systems on sealift 2013.
- b. Storage building project to enter into the design phase.
- c. Water Lagoon project and Sewage Treatment Plant projects to enter into the design phase.
- d. Runway design to be completed early to mid 2013/14 and move into construction phase. Design to be forwarded to NWB for review once completed.
- e. Building decommissioning project to enter design phase.
- f. Barrel washer crusher to be purchased and shipped for installation/use in summer of 2014.
- g. Fuel tank farm retrofit project to proceed into design in 2013 in order to award construction contract for construction in fall 2014.
- h. Weekly surveillance of the East Landfill monitoring station by on site EC personnel will take place during spring/summer of 2013 in order to evaluate the suitability of its location for obtaining surface water run off/leachate samples for analysis as required by the water licence requirements and as per AANDC inspection recommendation of 2012 (no run off water was available for sampling in 2012).
- i. The Eureka Remedial Action Plan (RAP) is currently under development by our Contaminated Sites Division.
