The Interim Abandonment and Restoration Plan satisfactorily addressed all of the requirements of Part I, Part 3 of the current water licence #3BC-EUR0611.

- Issuance of water license #3BC-EUR0611 was February 6, 2006
- Part I, Item 3: At least three (3) years prior to final abandonment, the Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval, a Final Abandonment and Restoration Plan. The Plan shall include in addition to the content of the Interim Plan, but not be limited to he following: (a-e)
- An Interim Abandonment and Restoration Plan was submitted on March 17, 2009

Re: 3BC-EUR0611 - Sludge Disposal Plan - Environment Canada - Eureka Weather Station

In reviewing the Sludge and Disposal Plan INAC concurs with the remediation option(s). It is noted however that the "options" analysis for sewage treatment and disposal has not been completed to date (expected in 2009). INAC is of the opinion that no sludge disposal should commence until this analysis has been completed and more definitive options have been provided. Therefore the proponent should be advised that this Plan is subject to any findings provided by Environment Canada's "options" analysis for sewage treatment and disposal, and further, those findings should be subject to review.
