The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Application for the amendment of the BAF-3 Nunavut Water Board water licence (8BC-BAF1929) with the following proposed changes:
 - a. Annual water use limit increase to 3000 cu m; and,
 - b. Increased staffing levels (9 members).
2. Associated NPC File No: 148957 [BAF-3, Brevoort Island Water Use Licence Renewal]; NIRB FILE No.: 03DN120
3. Location: Qikiqtaaluk [Brevoort Island; eastern Hall Peninsula east of Iqaluit]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal.

The NPC previously reviewed works and activities associated with the current project proposal including renewal of water license for BAF-3 in Brevoort Island and a determination was issued on October 17, 2018 (NPC file 148957) that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.

In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 03DN120).

This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NUPPAA) under section 235 of that Act. The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials are available at the following address:
