Your licence should make reference to your use of culverts around site; however, there is no mention of culvert use within your licence.

Please notify the board and have your licence amended for the ability to have culverts on site. If approved, this should then allow you to proceed with changing up the culvert in question.

RCL is in the early planning stages of a project to replace the culverts in the road at DYE-M. RCL hopes to replace the culverts with larger diameter culverts that will allow the spring freshet to pass more easily and prevent wash outs of the road.

As this project is in the early planning stages, details about the project are limited.

The site's water licence (3BC-DYE0919, Part C, item 5) states that "The Licensee shall not remove any material from below the ordinary high water mark of any water body unless authorized."

Please advise if this type of project triggers that clause in the licence, and if it does what steps are required for authorization.
