I am reviewing the new application form for the Dept. of National Defence, Eureka Project.

In the Supplementary questionary (Ques. #26) it says that "Water is obtained from the Environment Canada Weather Station located adjacent to the site. Environment Canada currently holds a license for water use and waste disposal (3BC-EUR0611). Water is trucked from the Env. Canada reservoir to Eureka Project where it is placed into the cistern system."

I had a look at Environment Canada's water Licence 3BC-EUR0611 for their Weather Station and it does not say anything in this license about any other Project coming in taking water under their water license. I am a little confused on what might be going on here. Can you help clarify this for me?!
