Afternoon Andrew,

I have been assigned to the Alert Station Licence.

Licence 3BC-ALT1015 expires July 31, 2015, and as you are aware, will be transitioning to a "Type A" classification. I would like to remind you, as described in the NWB's General Information Guides, that a Type A Licence usually requires approximately nine (9) months to process.

The previous technical advisor assigned to this file, Karen Kharatyan, indicated that your department was updating the O&M Plans and other relevant material to correctly reflect the Station's water use volumes.

I recognize that the 2014 Annual Report for the Licence indicates that DND will be submitting a renewal application; can you provide an expected time-period for when the NWB will be receiving the application?
