Good Afternoon Andrew,

Please note that I will be taking over this file from Brady MacCarl, as Technical Advisor.

Can you confirm if this Alert Station file 8AC-ALT----, has been submitted to the Nunavut Planning Commission?

Given that a complete application was only received after July 9th 2015, after the NLCA and NuPPAA amendments were in effect. Please be advised that under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), Article 11, Section 11.5.9 and s. 76 (1) of *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NuPPAA), the proponent of a project governed by NuPPAA is also required to submit a project proposal document (which may include the water licence application) directly to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC or Commission) for the NPC's determination regarding the applicable land use planning requirements and/or directions regarding whether the project is subject to screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board. In particular, please note that as established under Articles 11, 12 and 13 of the NLCA, NuPPAA and Part 3 of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, until the project has completed the applicable land use planning and assessment process required by the NPC and the NIRB, the NWB

cannot issue a water licence.
