Progressive and Final Reclamation Work Undertaken

Progressive Reclamation Work Undertaken in 2012:

Progressive and reclamation works were undertaken in July 2012 at CFS Eureka, Nunavut at the CFS Eureka North Airstrip Apron site to delineate and determine the extent of fuel contaminated soil. This area is a Federal Registered Contaminated Site (S-10527) under the Federal Contaminated Sites Action Plan (FCSAP). This location was identified by the Inspector during the July 2011 and 2012 Inspection Reports, and as such, DND will take action to seek bioremediation methods to reclaim this area while adhering to the 10-step process of FCSAP.



Delineation work being conducted in July 2012 at the CFS Eureka North Airstrip Apron site by DND and NRC. This area is located behind the main refuelling tanks where fuel bladders once existed.

Future works proposed for 2013:

There are two work proposed for the progressive and reclamation works to be undertaken in 2013 at CFS Eureka, Nunavut.

1. CFS Eureka North Airstrip Apron

DND and the National Research Council of Canada (NRC) will continue to assess the extent of contamination at CFS Eureka North Airstrip Apron area in summer 2013 for possible remediation options.

2. CFS Eureka Biopile (Landfarm) Facility

DND and NRC will mechanically rotate and apply nutrient fertilizers to stimulate the degradation (bioremediation) of fuel contaminated soils. This activity will hasten the remediation process for existing contaminated soils; DND intends to utilize this Facility for future soil remediation work.
