Good afternoon Phyllis,

We've got another issue with the Eureka WUL (No. 3BC-ERK1015). Part J of the licence requires that the licensee determine, in consultation with the Inspector, the GPS co-ordinates of all locations where wastes are deposited and have been deposited. These coords are required for annual report.

Fort Eureka has been closed for a few weeks at this point in time, and accordingly there are no more flights in this calendar year to the site (POL system is locked down and fuel distribution equipment has been removed and put away). I have been informed that a charter flight would be prohibitively expensive. We propose to collect this information in the spring of 2011, for inclusion in the following year's annual report. The 2010 annual report will identify locations of waste deposit using maps. Since there will not be any manual discharges until next year when the crew arrives, we hope this proposal is acceptable.

Please let me know if this proposal is acceptable to the board.
