Carl,

As per Part D section 8 of the NWB Licence No 3BC-EUR1116, you need to give the NWB 10 days advance notice that we will be decanting our sewage lagoon.

It takes about 48 hours to empty the lagoon and I will be taking samples at 1/3 empty & 2/3 empty... so after 16 hours and 32 hours.

Due to the scheduling of our produce flight this year, we will start pumping out the lagoon at midnight July 5th ,2014.

The first set of samples will be taken at 4 p.m. July 6th and the second set of samples will be taken at 8 a.m. July 7th.

After the second set of samples are taken, the samples have to make it to the lab within 8 hours so the first set of samples can get to the lab in Yellowknife within 24 hrs.

Please advise the appropriate parties of our schedule.
