Background			
Water Licence 3BC-FOD0919 issued to the Government of Canada Department of National Defence for the use of water not exceeding 1440m ³ annually and the deposit of waste during the operation and maintenance of the FOX-3 Long Range Radar Station located north of Dewar Lakes on Baffin Island within the Qikiqtani Region, Nunavut.			
Inspection			
1. Water Lake			
a) The licensee trucks water from the Water Lake to 6 (six) raw water tanks within the main facility.			
b) No signs of drawdown or erosion were noted during the inspection.			
c) This facility appears to be working as intended. See figure 1 for the water source.			
2. Sewage disposal facility			
a) The Licensee treats the sewage inside the main facility and disposes of it in a sump.			
b) This deposit of waste does not appear to effect inland waters, the nearest body of water is approximately 7Km from the sump.			
c) No issues were noted about this deposit of waste. See figure 2 for the sump.			
3. Historical spills			
a) On site there are two spills that are concerning, one being a pipe line failure and the other a helicopter crash.			
b) Both spills have been mentioned in past Water Licence inspection reports and remain in the same state.			
c) The Licensee had intention of constructing a engineered land farm in order to remediate the soil on site in 2017 but, a technical advisor at the NWB requested they get an amendment to their licence in order to construct a land farm.			
d) This request from the NWB has delayed the remediation of the spills until 2018.
