**Re: Department of National Defence – Amendment Applications – Type
“B” Water Licences - 3BC-CAM0409 (CAM-M Project) & 3BC-FOH0409
(FOX-M Dewar Lakes Project)**

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) has completed a review of the Department of National Defence's Type B Water Licence Amendment Applications for the CAM-M Project situated in the Kitikmeot Region and the FOX-M Dewar Lakes Project situated in the Qikiqtani Region. The proponent submitted their applications to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) on May 7th, 2009.

The Department of National Defence (DND) is requesting an extension to both licences (3BC-CAM0409 & 3BC-FOH0409) for a period of 3 months and 2 months respectively. The expiry date for both licences would be extended to September 1, 2009. This extension would allow the NWB time to approve the applications submitted by Nasittuq Corporation currently before the Board. These applications relate to Nasittuq assuming responsibility for the use of water and deposition of wastes at these sites.

INAC has no concerns with the extensions of licences # 3BC-CAM0409 & 3BC-FOH0409. However, DND should be reminded that there are to be no changes to any component of the site or project and that all terms and conditions of the current licences must be adhered to.
