

Background			
<p>Nunavut Water Licence 3BC-FOH0919 was issued to the Department of National Defence for the Deposit of Waste for the operation and maintenance of the FOX-M Long range Radar Station located beside Hall Beach, Qikiqtani Region, Nunavut.</p> <p>Although the licence explicitly says that water use is not permitted, the licence allows the Licencee to use up to 10m³ of water from a man-made reservoir that is owned and operated by the Hamlet of Hall Beach.</p> <p>The Licence also allow for the discharge of treated sewage from site.</p>			
Observations			
<p>A site inspection was completed on September 10th, 2015 to inspect the authorized uses of water and deposits of waste at FOX-3.</p>			
<u>Direct Water Use</u>			
<p>1. It was noted that all water for domestic camp purposes was being withdrawn from the Hamlet reservoir.</p> <p>a. Water records were available for inspection.</p> <p>b. No concerns.</p>			
<u>Water Management Structures</u>			
<p>2. <i>Berm surrounding fuel tanks on site.</i></p> <p>a. Berm wall surrounding the facility were sufficient. No signs of settlement, slope instability or seepages were noted.</p> <p>b. Freeboard heights were sufficient.</p>			
<u>Waste Disposal/Discharges</u>			
<p>3. <i>Sewage</i></p> <p>a. Black and grey water is treated on-site using a tertiary wastewater treatment system.</p> <p>b. Sewage outfall is in good order, no signs of erosion noted.</p> <p>c. No concerns.</p>			
<p>4. <i>Domestic Waste</i></p> <p>d. It was noted that all domestic waste is being transported to the Municipal Landfill at Hall Beach.</p>
